

M1.1 QUALITY POLICY

6. The level of demand regarding the acquired qualifications of the graduates in the labor market.
7. The efficient use of the financial resources of the Graduate Program from any source.
8. The conducting of an annual internal evaluation and review of the Quality Assurance System for the Graduate Program in collaboration with the Quality Assurance Group (OMEA) of the Faculty and the University’s Quality Assurance Unit (MODIP).
9. The conducting of a periodic external evaluation and review of the Quality Assurance System for the Graduate Program, after the recommendation of an External Evaluation Committee.
